The City of Monroe is now accepting applications for a vacancy on the Tree Board.

The responsibility of a Tree Board member is to develop, administer, and update annually a written plan for the care, preservation, pruning, planting, replanting, removal and/or disposition of trees and shrubs in parks, along streets and in other public areas. The Tree Board is also charged with conducting public education programs for the community regarding tree preservation and planting. The board will submit any and all findings to the City Council annually for acceptance and approval.

The Tree Board Member will:

- Serve a 3-year term without compensation beginning March 1, 2021.
- Act in an advisory capacity to the city council.
