Qualifications & Experience:

- High school diploma or GED; or equivalent combination of education, training, & experience.
- Possession of, or ability to obtain, an appropriate state-certified license for collection systems.
- Possession of or ability to obtain, a valid Georgia driver's license for the type of vehicle or equipment operated.

Skills & Abilities:

- Knowledge of pumps, mechanical systems, & basic electrical systems.
- Skill in reading & interpreting various meters.
- Ability to maintain accurate & detailed records
- Proficiency in the maintenance & repair of lift stations
- Experience that demonstrates an understanding of the principles related to collection system equipment maintenance (typically gained through two or more years on a related field)

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Monitors & assists in the operation of pump & lift stations to ensure compliance with federal and state regulations.
- Schedules repairs & corrective actions on pumps, controls, generators, & related equipment.
- Maintains accurate records, including logs of pump run times, station conditions, and maintenance activities.
- Inspects equipment performance & makes necessary repairs or replacements of pumps, controls, & devices.
- Performs routine cleaning of equipment & facilities; maintains grounds as needed.
- Completes other related duties as assigned.
