The City of Monroe is seeking a Recycling Truck Driver. This position is responsible for driving a recycling truck along a residential route to collect the city's recycling. Salary is commensurate with qualifications. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions of the job.

Qualifications & Experience:

- High school diploma or GED; or equivalent combination of education, training, & experience.
- 1-2 years of experience operating heavy vehicles or similar equipment preferred.
- Valid Commercial Driver's License (CDL), Class B, or ability to obtain one.
- Flagging certification or ability to obtain one.

Skills & Abilities:

- Knowledge of recycling collection routes, city streets, & departmental safety rules.
- Ability to safely operate a recycling truck and related equipment (chipper, asphalt, & refuse trucks).
- Basic vehicle maintenance skills, including checking fluid levels & changing & repairing tires.
- Defensive driving skills & adherence to traffic regulations.
- Ability to read & interpret safety rules, operating instructions, & procedure manuals.
- Strong problem-solving & reasoning abilities for fieldwork situations.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Drive recycling truck along assigned residential routes to collect recyclable materials.
- Transport recyclable materials to designated transfer stations.
- Perform basic maintenance checks & minor repairs on trucks & equipment.
- Operate additional vehicles, including refuse, asphalt, or chipper trucks, as needed.
- Assist with street maintenance and repair projects.
- Serve as a traffic flagger for worksite safety.
- Follow safety protocols & departmental procedures.
- Perform other related duties as assigned.
